



# References US – 579 MW in operation

Wind Works Power Corp. acquired Global Winds Harvest in 2015.

Global Winds Harvest former CEO is now CEO of Wind Works Power Corp.

The first 3 projects were successfully developed by Global Winds Harvest,

The subsequent 2 projects were successfully (co)developed by Wind Works:

- 2006: Bear Creek, **Pennsylvania 24 MW**
  - Sold to CEI (Iberdrola) who built and operates it
  - 12 x Gamesa G87 2 MW
- 2008: Tatanka, **North Dakota/ South Dakota 180 MW**
  - Sold to Acciona who built and operates the project
  - 120 x Acciona AWE 1.5 MW
- 2009: Cohocton, **New York 125 MW**
  - Sold to First Wind who built and operates the project
  - 50 x Clipper 2.5 MW
- 2015&18: Thunder Spirit **North Dakota 150 MW**
  - Sold to MN Power who built and operates the project
  - 43 Nordex N100 + 8 Nordex N117
- 2018: Zep-Solar, **North Carolina 100 MW**
  - Sold to Recurrent who built and operates the project
